The state treasurer has full power to regulate the custody and safe-keeping of the fund, and is required to keep it invested in the capital stock of some responsible bank or banking institution or in bonds of the towns and cities of the state. All moneys paid into the state treasury by auctioneers are added to the capital of this fund. The annual income of the fund, with enough additional appropriated from the general treasury to aggregate 90,000, is annually distributed as follows: 63,000 among the several towns according to the number of children under 15 years of age, and 27,000 according to the number of school districts therein.
